Next Week in School...

Next week we will learn all about the different cultures of the world. We will eat food and learn customs from 10 different countries. We will see the flag for each country and even make a book of flags from different countries. We will read stories and watch videos that show us what it is like around the world.

In phonics, we will learn letter "Z/z". We have finally reached the end of the alphabet. We will continue to review all the letters and how they all work together to form words. Please continue to review all the letters and sounds at home with your child.

We have continued to learn addition and subtraction up to 10. We have also continued telling time and counting by 5s.

In Bible, we learned about the Lord's Prayer. We learned that Jesus was teaching people how to pray and gave them this example. Our class got to stand in front of everyone at chapel and teach the other children to say the Lord's Prayer.

Past Week

This past week in class, we learned all about Dr. Seuss. We learned about his life and read many stories that he has written. We talked a lot of about rhyming and how Dr. Seuss used rhyming to tell fun, silly stories to help teach children to love reading. We made Dr. Seuss themed crafts, and practiced our rhyming skills. The children enjoyed all the theme days and showing off their Dr. Seuss Spirit.

In Phonics, we learned about the letter "Y/y". We also practiced rhyming and making our own silly rhyming words. We read Dr. Seuss books and the kids were able to guess the next words just by rhyming. In Math, we continued to practice addition and subtraction and telling time.

We finally got plenty of outside time due to the gorgeous spring weather. The children were so excited to be able to play outside without being bundled in snow gear. It tends to be very muddy this time of year so continuing to bring snow boots or rain boots in addition to in class shoes in a good idea.

In bible, we learned the story of the good Samaritan. We learned that when someone is in trouble, you should always help. Jesus was telling this story to teach people what it means to love your neighbor and who counts as a neighbor. Jesus calls us to love everyone like our neighbor; demonstrating Jesus' love.
